

STUDENT ASSEMBLY FOR PROCESSION INTO PAULEY PAVILION ON SUNDAY, JUNE 15

Please come to Gate #15 of Pauley Pavilion promptly at 8:30 a.m. to prepare for the processional into Pauley Pavilion. Gate 15 is next to the Morgan Center and across from the IM Field. Your guests will not be allowed into this area. Here you will fill in a card with a guide to pronouncing your name. Degree candidates will form a line along the wall of Pauley and be led into the floor of Pauley by department faculty and General Wesley Clark, the keynote speaker.

There will be a professional photography service working at the graduation that takes a picture of each graduate on stage. Staff from the photography company will provide and distribute cards that will be completed by graduates. The cards will be used to call names as the graduates are acknowledged on stage and to mail photo proofs. The phonetic spelling of your name may be written on the card.

At the end of the ceremony the graduating seniors will have a recessional from the floor of Pauley to outside the arena. Your guests can immediately exit and meet you outside of Gate #15.

All guests to the commencement require a ticket for admission into Pauley Pavilion. There will be no admission without a ticket. The guideline for children is that anyone requiring their own seat will need a ticket. In general children under 4 are not required to have a ticket but if children older than 4 will not need their own seat then no ticket is necessary. The degree candidates are not required to have a ticket. Only the College Commencement event for the College of Letters and Science commencement event on Friday, June 13, requires that degree candidates have a ticket.

Additional guest tickets are available for the department commencement event and may be ordered at the undergraduate office, 4269 A or B in Bunche Hall, through June 13 as space permits. Please contact the Political Science undergraduate counselors for assistance offered to disabled guests. Pauley Pavilion will be set up at 3/4 court for the event and in this configuration has a 7,000 person capacity. Expected attendance is 5,000 which includes nearly 500 graduating seniors.

Make sure to pick up your guest tickets ahead of time-there will be no ticket pick-up on the day of the commencement. You must RSVP for departmental graduation ceremonies on MyUCLA and order your guest tickets between April 29th and May 14th. Ticket pickup will occur between May 19th and June 2nd. **The deadline for picking up tickets is June 2nd.**
